	frustration, force majeure, rent suspension, covenant release; yielding up vacant possession; execution of deeds in the era of social distancing.
Timed Out (Law 40)	What the Coronavirus Act 2020 and its associated legislation and the various moratoria will be when
	the emergency period is over.
Retired Out	(1) The fate of, or likely for, some businesses
	because of coronavirus.
	(2) One's professional predecessors who
