Major which seems to have given it second life, and an attempt to rationalise where these decisions leave us. The seminar will be led by Nathaniel Duckworth and John Summers.

#### 9th February 2010

#### When Black Equals White: Construing Documents.

How are the principles of construction applied to documents commonly encountered by property litigators and conveyancers? Is there any scope for relying on evidence of the parties' negotiations? When can a mistake in a document be corrected by construing it? The seminar will be led by Adam Rosenthal and Joseph Ollech.

#### 17th March 2010

#### Nothing guaranteed?

Some topical issues concerning the liability of guarantors and former tenants under leases, guarantees and AGAs.

The seminar will be led by Edward Peters and Elizabeth Fitzgerald.

#### 20th April 2010

#### Break Options - Securing the release of tenants' obligations.

In a difficult economic climate landlords are often keen to retain the benefit of the covenants of existing tenants rather than face the prospect of rent voids. This Seminar will review the law relating to the exercise of break clauses and provide some practical advice on ensuring that break clauses are effectively operated.
