Enfranchisement: recent developments in law and practice.

Over the last year, enfranchisement issues have kept courts, tribunals and practitioners as busy as ever. Decisions at appellate level have touched on matters of law, procedure and valuation, and the perennial question of 'what is a house?' still seems open to debate. Recent developments will be reviewed and practical tips offered under both the 1967 and 1993 Acts.

Service Charges Workshop.

Two maintenance and service charge scenarios, in commercial and residential premises will be worked through. This will be a practical guide and legal update on these frequent and sometimes complicated issues. The focus will be on audience participation. 3rd May 2016

Forfeiture: Recap and Update.

This seminar will look at the fundamental principles underlying forfeiture claims and explore some of the problems most commonly encountered in practice, including issues of waiver. It will also look at the latest developments in the law of forfeiture, including:

- Notices under s.146 LPA 1925 and the definition of "rent".
- The recovery of costs of forfeiture proceedings.
- Relief from forfeiture following the trio of Court of Appeal decisions in Magnic v Ul-Hassan and anor [2015] EWCA Civ 224, Safin (Fursecroft) Limited v Badrig [2015] EWCA Civ 739 and Freifeld v West Kensington Court Limited [2015] EWCA Civ 806.
- The circumstances in which damages for use and occupation (mesne profits) can be claimed by the Landlord, and the date from which they run.

15th June 2016

Implied Terms, Break Clauses and Rent Apportionment.

Issues arising from Marks & Spencer v BNP Paribas [2015] UKSC 72, set to be the leading decision of the Supreme Court on implied terms, break clauses and the apportionment of rent will be considered. The seminar will focus on the applicable test for the implication of a term, apportionment of rent, the repayment of rent following the exercise of a break option, and lessons to be learned going forwards, including how to advise in relation to the operation of break clauses and the drafting of leases.
